

Oxnard Christmas Parade, Saturday, December 3rd, 2022 10am to 12 noon - Staging Instructions

Dear Participant,

Thank you for your participation in the 2022 Oxnard Christmas Parade. To stay in touch with all our holiday happenings and year-round events in downtown Oxnard please follow DowntownOxnard on Instagram or Facebook. We will be posting photos and videos of the parade on those platforms.

Staging Instructions:

#1 Please review the attached spreadsheet for your Staging number and Entry name.

- #2 Upon arrival at **Check In** (S/W corner of Ninth and A Streets) you will be instructed to proceed to your staging location which will be chalked on the pavement. A staging map is in production and we will be posting that on our website, downtown Oxnard social media and emailing to you in a second email.
- #3 Check-in time: Parade Check-In is 7:00am to 8:45 am. Nearby streets start closing at 9:00am. All entries must be set up by 9:30am. Vehicle(s) and float(s) registered in parade are to enter staging at: C & 9th Street. Bring this document with you! See attached map for the Ninth and B Street **Parking Drop Off** area this is for people being dropped off to join the parade. Unloading parking for 20 minutes is available for parents walking youth to their assigned entry numbers.

Parade End: C Street and 2nd (Pease do not park directly behind Oxnard Public Library)

TO AVOID CONFUSION AND FOR SAFETY, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Have one representative from your group check-in with the Parade Committee at the check-in table no later than 8:45 AM at the Corner of 9th and A Streets. Your representative will pick up the official number cards to affix to the right and left side of your entry. Bring a pin, string or tape, but we will have some supplies with us as well.
- 2. If you registered a float or vehicle(s), your representative will be given **official passes** at check in for each. These passes must be displayed in the window of your vehicle to be admitted onto the parade route.
- 3. Entries are encouraged to perform during the parade, but you must keep moving as you perform! There is **ONE ALLOWABLE STOP** at the Main Judges stand located at the South end of Plaza Park on 5th Street. Official performance must be **One Minute or Less** for our panel of judges at this **ONE location**. A sign will be posted on a barricade alerting you to the "Competition area". If your music does not start within 10 seconds at the main judging stage you will be asked to forfeit your performance. Please make sure your sound is ready.

- **JUNIOR & HIGH SCHOOL BANDS ONLY:** Band Judging is done on C Street just before the Carnegie Museum. The designated area will be marked as BAND competition area.
- 4. No candy, confetti, or any objects to be **thrown** during the parade for safety reasons. Promotional items can be handed out by walkers.
- 5. NO SANTAS PLEASE! The City of Oxnard will provide the only Santa allowed as the grand finale.
- 6. All floats are required to carry a 5lb. Fire extinguisher by the order of the Fire Department. No extinguisher, No participation!
- 7. Parade officials (in safety vests) will let you know when to proceed into the parade route when it starts. Stay near the entry in front of you to avoid large gaps in the parade.
- 8. The parade ends at 2nd and C Streets, behind City Hall (like previous years).

 Please follow Police and Parade Monitor's directions. Failure to follow directions can cause you to not be invited back to the parade next year.
- 9. Youth under 18 that are on bikes must wear safety helmets.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- 1. Call the Parade office, at (805) 247.0197, if anything significant in your entry has changed since turning in the paperwork and updates you may have provided by 5pm on Friday, Dec. 2nd
- 2. If you are part of a large group, please carpool to the parade if possible.
- 3. Encourage your group to park in the public parking structure at 4th and B Streets or any City parking lots. Do not park your car in private lots designated "No Parking". **You can be towed!** There are no time limits in any public parking areas the day of the parade.
- 4. Please bring water and snacks for your group.
- 5. Port a Potties are available in the School District parking lot and on 9th Street between A Street. They are noted with an "R" on the attached map. There are also two restrooms at the parade end. Restrooms are available near Plaza Park adjacent to the Tamale Festival.
- 6. No float, vehicles or horse trailers are to be left in the staging area. The School District Lot will be closed right after the parade. Arrange for pick up behind City Hall on Second and B street. The designated "pick-up" area is located on the map right near the "R" for restroom and can be accessed by First street and the alley (between B Street & C Street as noted with a star on the map).

Horses:

- You will receive a pass at the check-in table for the number of animals you have indicated on your application. Do not bring additional animals!
- Please clean up after your horses in the staging and de-staging area.
- Horses cannot return back to the staging area. All trailers need to be removed by 9:00 AM and placed in the designated area along B Street or C Street between 1st and 2nd Street. DO NOT WALK HORSES ON SIDEWALKS.
- The Parade Committee has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy towards animal abuse. Any person abusing animals before, during, or after the parade shall be reported to the appropriate legal entity.


